Make sure you and everyone around you has a good time on and off the pitch. This Code of Conduct explains how you can play your part:



- ✓ lead by example put in maximum effort and perform to your best
- $\checkmark$  be a a positive role model for others, particularly other players and supporters
- ✓ always have regard for the best interests of the game and the club, including where publicly expressing an opinion and when addressing others in football
- ✓ promote sportsmanship, fair play and abide by the laws of the game
- ✓ accept success and failure, victory and defeat with an equal measure of dignity
- $\checkmark$  take care of equipment and facilities as if they were your own
- ✓ respect everyone and celebrate difference do not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of gender, race, sexual orientation, ability or any other protected characteristic
- ✓ report any incidents of racism, sexism or bullying to a club member, even if you're just a witness
- ✓ talk to the Club Welfare Officer if you have a concern to report, are unhappy about something or have anything you need to share (details of how to report something are detailed on our website and are displayed at JW Park)
- ✓ respect your coaches, our club members, the officials and the opposition
- ✓ always leave a tidy changing room and clubhouse, home or away
- ✓ get involved in club decisions and contribute towards the development of our club
- ✓ pay your JWFC subscriptions on time and engage in club events
- ✓ respect the laws of the game and the discipline procedures of the club all players are expected to pay for any fines relating to descent

We expect all senior players who represent Jersey Wanderers FC to follow the behaviours and requests set out in this Code of Conduct. If any player behaves in a way which contradicts any of the points set out above, we'll address the problem straight away and aim to resolve the issue.

Continued issues and repeated breaches of this code may result in us regrettably asking you to leave the session, event or club permanently. We may also ask you to apologise or issue you with a formal warning. This is something we never want to do.
