

## Code of Conduct for all JWFC Under 18 Players

Play your best. Do your best. Be your best.

To ensure that we create a great environment for everyone to enjoy football both on and off the pitch, by registering to play for Jersey Wanderers FC, you agree to the following:



- ✓ keep yourself safe by listening to your coach(es), behaving responsibly and speaking out when something isn't right
- ✓ take care of equipment and facilities as if they were your own
- ✓ get to sessions/matches on time and let your coach know if you're running late
- ✓ bring the right kit to training and dress appropriately for the weather
- ✓ be a good teammate and always play your best for the benefit of the team
- ✓ talk to the Club Welfare Officer if you have a concern to report, are unhappy about something or have anything you need to share (details of how to report something are detailed on our website and are displayed at JW Park)
- ✓ do not smoke or consume alcohol during training, competitions or at any time when representing Jersey Wanderers FC
- ✓ respect everyone and celebrate difference - do not discriminate against anyone else on the grounds of gender, race, sexual orientation, ability or any other protected characteristic
- ✓ report any incidents of racism, sexism or bullying to a club member, even if you're just a witness
- ✓ play fairly and appreciate that everyone has different levels of skill, talent and ability
- ✓ make our club a welcoming and friendly place to be
- ✓ respect your coaches, our club members, the officials and the opposition
- ✓ have fun, be a good sport, celebrate when we win and be gracious when we lose
- ✓ get involved in club decisions - it's your sport too!
- ✓ respect the laws of the game and the discipline procedures of the club - all players are expected to pay for any fines relating to descent

As a Jersey Wanderers FC player, we understand you have the right to:

- ✓ enjoy the time you spend with us and know that you're safe
- ✓ be listened to
- ✓ be included and treated fairly
- ✓ be respected by the club, your coaches, your teammates and other club members
- ✓ feel welcomed, valued and not judged based on your race, gender, sexuality, ability or any other protected characteristic
- ✓ be encouraged and develop your football skills with our help and support

We expect all players who represent Jersey Wanderers FC to follow the behaviours and requests set out in this Code of Conduct. If anyone behaves in a way which contradicts any of the points set out above, we'll address the problem straight away with parent/guardian's involvement (if appropriate) and aim to resolve the issue.

Continued issues and repeated breaches of this code may result in us regrettably asking you to leave the session, event or club permanently, for the welfare of other young people and our club. We may also ask you to apologise or issue a formal warning. This is something we never want to do.
