Code of Conduct for all Parents/Guardians of JWFC Under 18 players

As a parent/guardian of a Under 18 person playing football for Jersey Wanderers FC, we'd like you to follow this guidance to make sure everyone in our club is able to participate safely and enjoy football.

It is important to remember that no matter the age, gender or ability of the individual, they are here to



play football and have fun. With your support, we can maintain a positive, welcoming and encouraging environment where everyone enjoys playing the game we all love. This Code of Conduct explains how you can play your part as part of our Jersey Wanderers FC community:

- ✓ remember that your expectations and attitudes have significant bearing on an individual's engagement and behaviour towards other players, officials, coaches and spectators
- ✓ always use positive and encouraging language towards everyone involved in the game or activity, not just those that you are supporting
- ✓ avoid coaching an individual during training or matches, as this can be confusing for both the player, team and coach
- ✓ respect the officials' and coaches' decisions, but speak to us calmly if you have any questions
- ✓ always applaud the opposition as well as our own team
- ✓ adhere and promote our club's Codes of Conducts and safeguarding standards
- ✓ pay your JWFC subscriptions on time and engage in club events
- ✓ speak to the Club Welfare Officer or a trusted club member if you have a concern you wish to raise about anyone in our club or within football (details of who to talk to when reporting something are on our website, up in our clubhouse and communicated regularly via email)

We expect everyone who represents Jersey Wanderers FC to follow the behaviours and requests set out in this Code of Conduct. If anyone behaves in a way which contradicts any of the points set out above, we'll address the problem straight away and aim to resolve the issue.

Continued issues and repeated breaches of this code may result in us regrettably asking you and your associates to leave the session, event or club permanently. This is something we never want to do.
